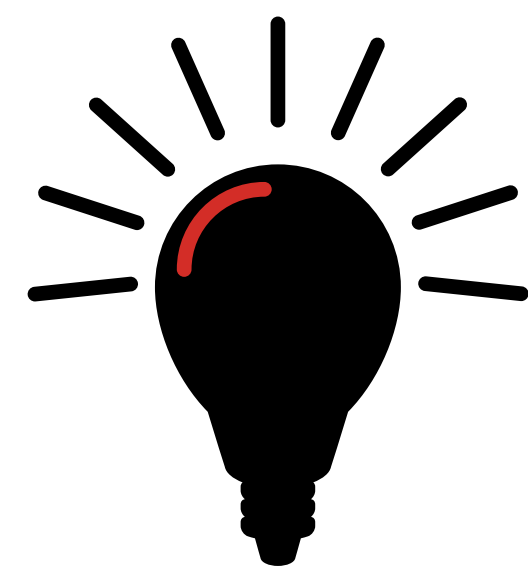

Remember your master password and forget the rest.



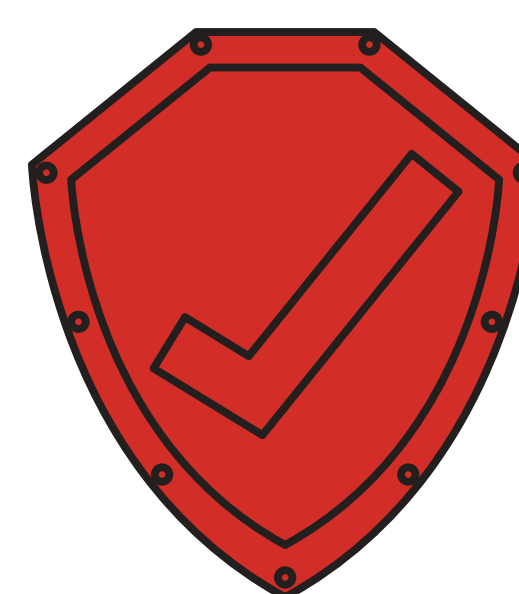
Access passwords everywhere

Use the password generator feature to create long, strong, and unique passwords.

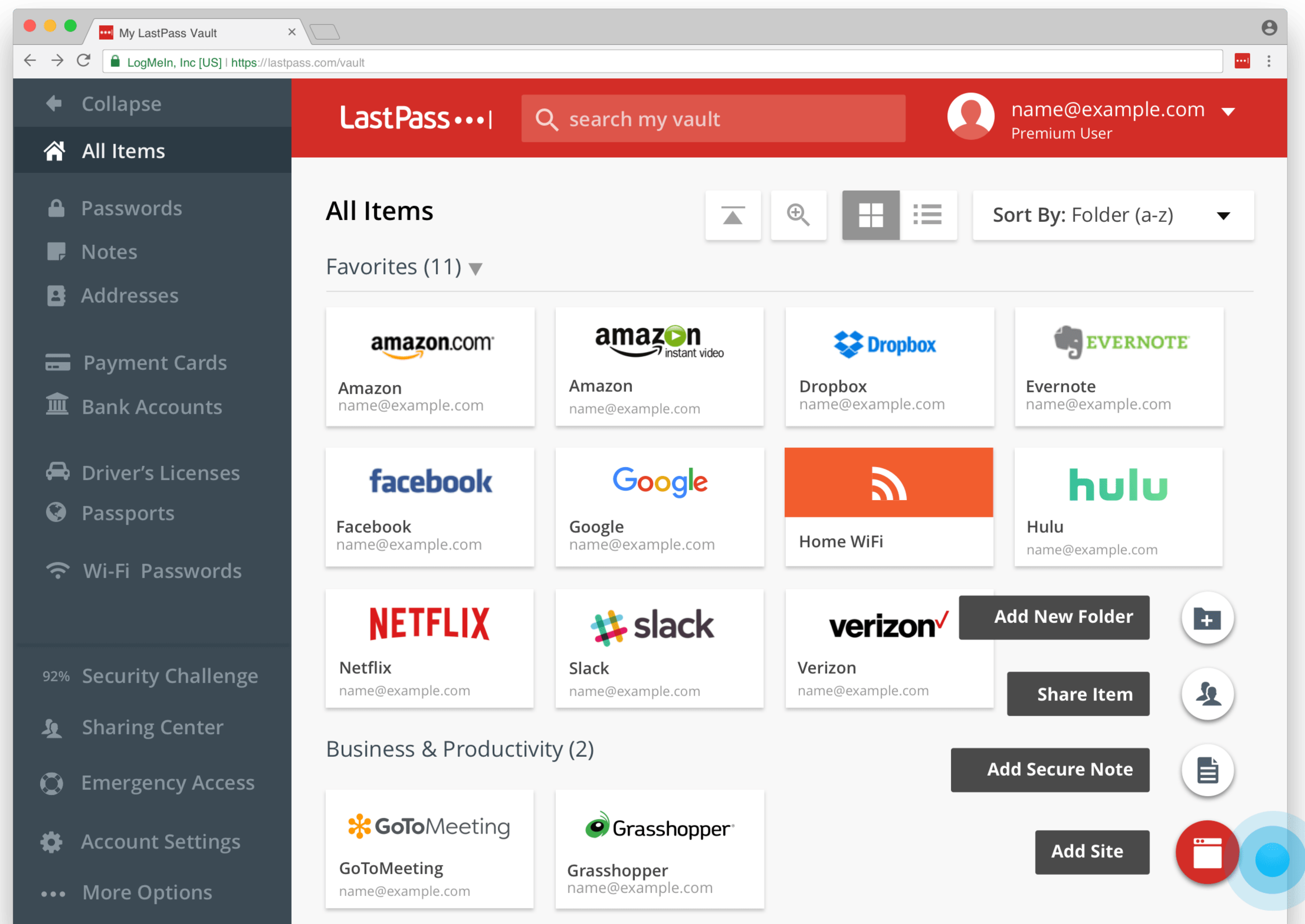


Feel confident with MFA

What is it and why should I use it?

LastPass is a secure, electronic password manager that stores your usernames and passwords in one place, called a vault. After you save a password to your vault, LastPass remembers it for you. When you need to log in to a website, LastPass enters your username and password for you.



Securely share passwords & notes

Safely share passwords and notes with other LastPass users (even those using the free version).



Save time with auto form fills

Use form fills to store addresses, credit cards, banking information, etc.



Take the security challenge

This feature analyzes your stored passwords and gives you an overall score. Use this to identify issues and improve your security.



Create secure notes

Think of it as a password-protected, digital notepad that you can access from anywhere.
